## Brigitte Werneburg takes a tour of the galleries in Berlin

Sandberg would have worked wonderfully in the summer group show "Shadow/Existence" at ScheiblerMitte. Among the wonderfully chosen works of ten artists, including Öyvind Fahlström, Mark Lombardi or Jorinde Voigt, Michael Wutz (born 1979) stands out with his fantastic animation film "Limbus Parvulorum" (2006) in which one can take a delightfully unsavory rollercoaster ride through an amusement park that appears to be a mixture of Baroque church architecture and Dante's Inferno. Both morbid and Pop, figurative and abstract, the film paints a picture of just the kind of ambivalent, shadowy existence addressed in the exhibition.
