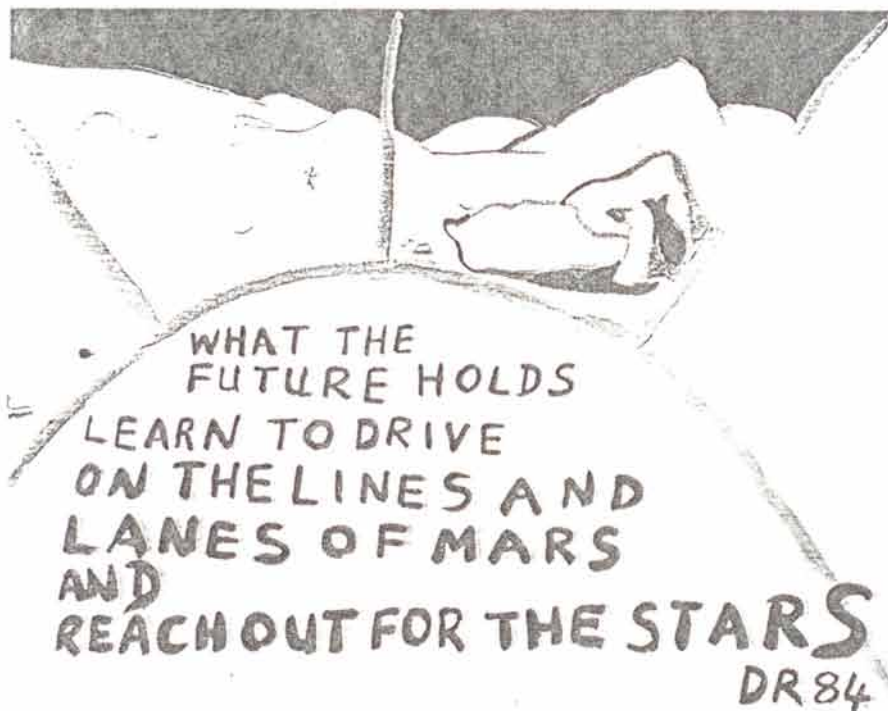

■ A Roomful of Hungry Looks

Starting on 9 April the Stedelijk Museum presents the exhibition 'A Roomful of Hungry Looks' - paintings and drawings by British painter/poet David Robilliard.

Robilliard was a romantically passionate artist, highly intense in his relations with others. He saw life and art as deliberate mutual extensions. His poetry, paintings and drawings form a condensed, staccato-like chronicle of his life in London in the eighties. Although he had always drawn, Robilliard only came to painting in 1985, making him something of a late starter. His initial drawings were pure word pictures: fragments of verse written in watery letters. He also painted portraits of friends and acquaintances, configured in thin lines. Robilliard's paintings are characterised by an interchange between the visual and the verbal elements of the picture.

This exhibition can be seen until 1 June 1993.



■ Live on board 'De Amsterdam'

You can experience a piece of 18th century history on board the East Indiaman 'De Amsterdam'. The ship is moored at the landing of the Rijksmuseum Nederlands Scheepvaartmuseum. The sailors of olden days have returned to 'their former employer'. They re-enact their daily life on board the ship. 'The living history' takes place in the year 1750. 'De Amsterdam' has returned from the East. The seamen are busy with different activities. The captain is arranging his affairs. A part of the crew unloads the goods. Others pump water out of the ship. The cook prepares a meal. Everyone can taste his delicious peas with bacon. Visiting 'De Amsterdam' offers a unique opportunity to get acquainted with the history of the East India company and the hard life on board an East Indiaman.
